## Interior Color Schedule

This color schedule designates the color and sheen that will be used throughout your home. Wet areas are baths, kitchens, and utility areas where moisture may exist. A luster finish is applied to both walls and ceilings in wet areas. If an area does not apply to what's being painted simply write "n/a" in the column. If more colors are being used, let us know and we'll get you another schedule.

\*\* Closets are not painted with the room, unless specified in the Scope of Work. They must be emptied of all contents prior to painting. If you would like to have them painted at the same time as the room we can be of assistance; simply let us know.

A change order then will be submitted to the client for the additional cost of the materials purchased to correct the color.
